OVERVIEW

This document offers simple steps to resolve some common issues that you might encounter with the template Stories, you import.

While we try to ensure that all the template Stories work seamlessly after you import them into your system, there's always a slim possibility that the Story you import isn't working.

Note: Before you delve into the troubleshooting instructions, please remember to read the functional guide that provides you an overview of all the template stories. Also, please read the technical document that accompanies each ACN Story template file.

One of the most common reasons of encountering a broken Story template could be the availability of products in your tenant or the difference in the system configuration between your system and the system used to create the content Stories.

Remember: To use a template Story, please ensure that the products mentioned in the "Component List" section of the accompanying technical document are available and active in your tenant.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation, and we strive to make your experience of working with template Stories easier and simpler in future releases.


PREVIEW THE QUERY

If the Story is imported, but no data is shown or there are some errors in the Story Page, you need to first verify if the query is working. Please edit the Story and preview the query.

To do so please open the story, and click on Edit

COMPARE THE FIELDS IN THE QUERY AND IN THE SYSTEM

Navigating to "Manage Business Configuration" from the Search Bar or Admin Center





This will lead you to the Admin Center - Business Config page

You can compare the Fields in your system with the **Technical Document** available with the Story's zip file download. This will help in locating the fields that are used in the Story, but not available in your system as is.

The fastest fix is to remove these fields from the query and checking the *Preview*. Once the preview is working you can add the relevant field available in your system in the query to fetch the required data.

Kindly open either the *Technical Documentation* (as mentioned above) **or** the *Query Designer* as shown in <u>Step one</u>.



In-case you are already on Preview query, you can simply click Hide Preview. Please click on the "Create Calculated Column" button on the top left corner



Once the query is fixed and the preview is working, the widgets and the tables should populate data. In case there are some fields used in the widgets that are not in the system, they need to be fixed in the Designer.
